



CHAPLAIN Job Description & Responsibilities

Responsibilities

The Chaplain, a ringing cleric, is an elected position and is a member of the Executive Committee and is able to attend the meetings of that Committee and participate in the decision-making processes. All members of the Executive Committee are charity trustees under the Charity Act.

The Role

- to provide pastoral care to the Association or it's members;
- to assist with the preparation of the Annual Service and to participate on the day, usually leading Intercession;
- to provide guidance to the Association officers as requested.
